Stars - March is Optimism Month

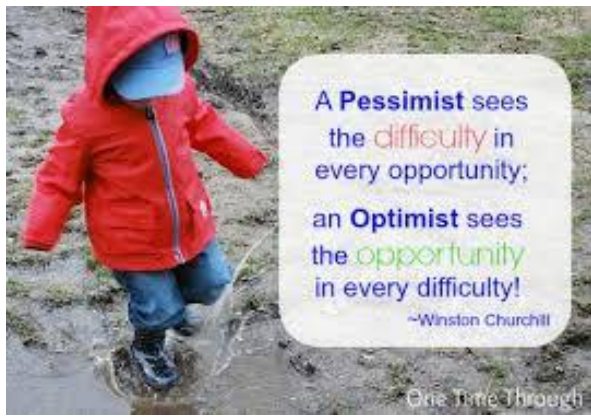
Our March STARS theme is
