This has been our focus for the month of September. We have been revisiting and teaching recognition of emotions and how to regulate them. We have also focused on teaching/reviewing our four school rules. This month's lessons were targeted on rule number one. Several students were recognized for showing exemplary demonstrations of this rule in our September Whole School assembly. We also started our Praise slip program where students receive a yellow slip of paper indicating that they have been "caught" demonstrating one of our school rules. All educators are happily giving these out and our students are super motivated to earn them! October's focus will be on rule number two.

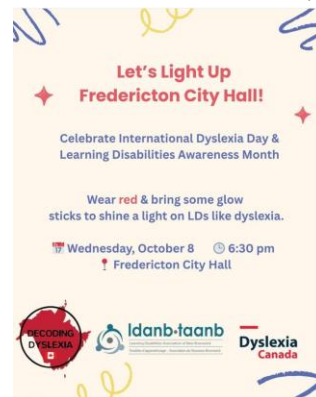
School Pictures!
